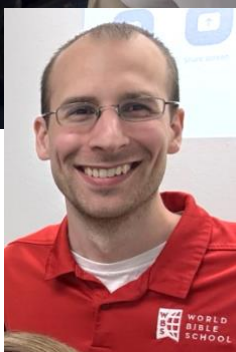

Welcome my president WBS and as of last week we managed to baptised two of our Students so I share the photos

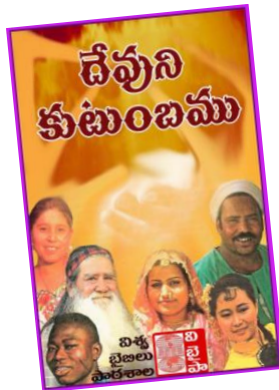




From Uyai Joshua, Nigeria (September):

Monday Akpakpan reports 73 baptisms in September and October 2025!

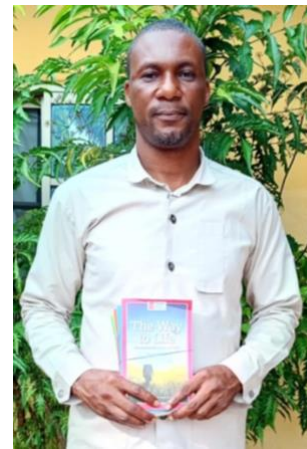


We continue to make progress with our translation of the WBS Master Series in Telugu, finishing up with the first seven courses.

John Kuach and I taught the gospel of Jesus Christ in the small village called Rum-Weet Macham congregation for the first time. We conducted a three day teaching in that particular area to share with them the good news.

By God's grace, we witnessed 14 new souls being surrendered their lives to Jesus Christ as their saviour and make him as their own hope for eternal life. 14 new souls were added to the Kingdom of God, the newness life. As they borne again and they put Christ on them.

After, they believe in Jesus Christ and accept to be Baptized according to the Bible. They were ecstatic and grateful for what God made today in their area for the first time since they had no church.

Some of them were misleading by the other denomination churches such as Catholic, Sabbath day and many more. They realised today that they were in the wrong direction.

All the people in that area believe that Jesus is the only source they will get the eternal life .

We anticipate that there will be many more new souls tomorrow as some of them were not ready and other weren't getting information. The information will reach them later.

This past month (September) has been full of fruitful labor in the Lord's vineyard here in Zimbabwe.

1. Manicaland – Buwerimwe (Bocha)

Through our partnership with World Bible School (WBS), another congregation has been planted in Buwerimwe, Bocha, with 23 souls saved. Brothers Ignituous, Zuva, and Kuzipa are zealously recruiting WBS students, and we then disciple them into maturity in Christ.

2. Mt. Dema Official Launch

We celebrated the official launch of the Mt. Dema congregation with the support of local congregations and community leaders. I taught the multitudes on "A Healthy Church," and the Lord added 11 new souls to His kingdom. This fruit is also part of the WBS efforts through the three brothers.

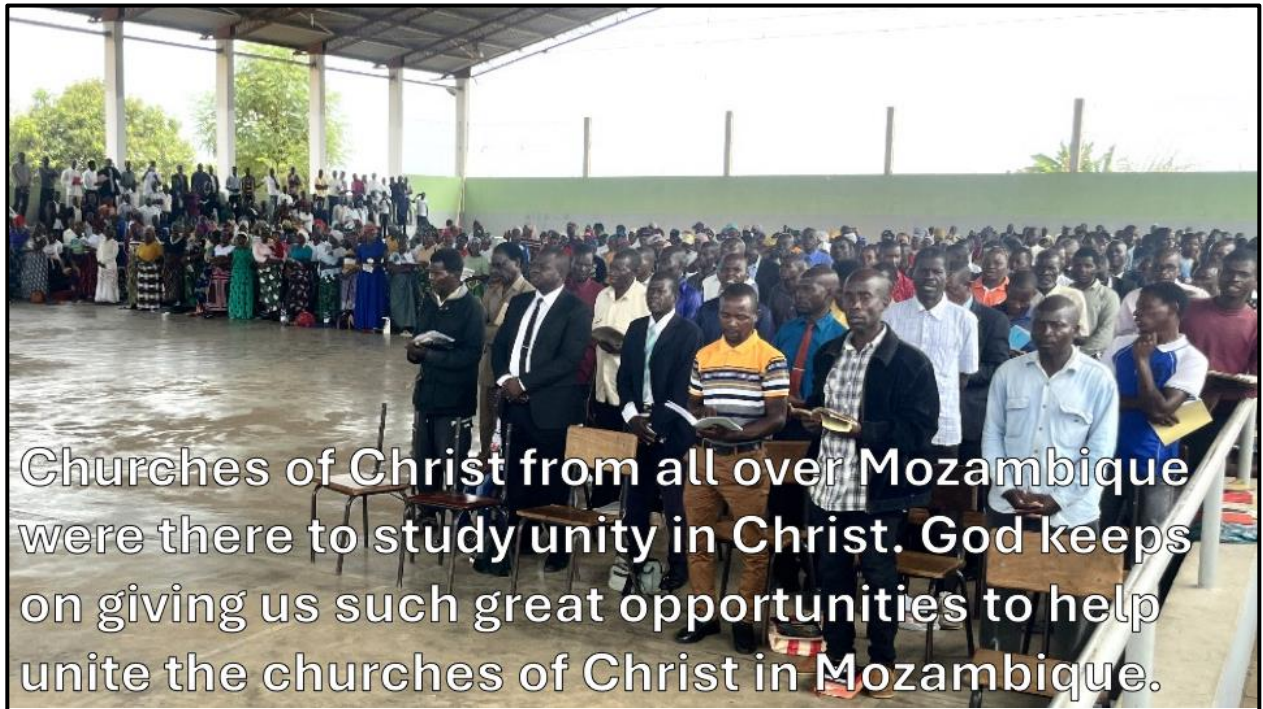
